△ Candidate must be a United States citizen or permanent United States resident.

△ Candidate must maintain a permanent residence in the Greater Harrisburg (PA) area but may attend school elsewhere.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Children of members of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. are not eligible to receive scholarship awards.

Carolyn Henry Scholarship – (1 scholarship available, four-year scholarship) This scholarship is awarded to one graduating high school senior with plans to attend a four-year college or university. The recipient of this scholarship must maintain a 3.0 GPA or better throughout the entire duration of the award and must be a full-time student. This scholarship is intended for students planning to major in the education field (major and full-time student status must be confirmed by the college/university).

Zena B. Miles Scholarship – (1 scholarship available, four-year scholarship) This scholarship is awarded to one graduating high school senior with plans to attend a four-year college or university. The recipient of this scholarship must maintain a 3.0 GPA or better throughout the entire duration of the award and must be a full-time student. This scholarship is intended for female students planning to major in the sciences field (major and full-time student status must be confirmed by the college/university).

Minerva Scholarship – (multiple scholarships available) These scholarships will be awarded to graduating high school seniors with plans to attend a four-year college or university. This is a one-time awarded scholarship.
